 Died--At his residence in Liberty Tp., on Monday, April 22 of Typhoid Fever, Mr. Daniel Cusac, in the 78th year of his age. The deceased had been a resident of this county for almost twenty-five years. He was a man of irreproachable character, and always had the respect and good will of his neighbors. None knew him but to respect him and he was most loved by those who knew him best. In fact he was what the poet so happily describes as "the noblest work of God," and 'honest man." He was a regular member and communicant of the Presbyterian Church for more than fifty years, and died in the full faith of the purifying efficacy of the Christian religion. He leaves a family of nine children (among whom is Hon. I. Cusac, our present Representative.) to mourn his departure from their midst.

3) "Unity Church, at Rehoboth, Perry co., Ohio was formed in 1820 and is the mother of the Presbyterian Church. Rev. James Culbertson came from Zanesville, once a month beginning in 1811 and preached in a barn or a wood. Preached the last time in 1814 in Isaac Sellers' barn. Isaac Sellers died in 1818 aged 49." He could be the father of Sarah Sellers Cusac as the Pennsylvania census of 1790 lists John Sellers, Jr., Isaac Sellers and Jacob Sellers, Sr. as residents of Mifflin Co., PA. ANOTHER OLD PIONEER Has Answered the Last Summons.

Mrs. Margret Poe Dies at Ripe Old Age of Eight-seven Years. An Early Settler of This County. Mrs. Margret Poe one of the oldest and much respected residents of Hancock County died early Friday morning at the residence of Martin Loy at McComb. The cause of death resulting from the infirmities of old age. Mrs. Poe was born in Perry County, Ohio, February 28 1818, her maiden name being Cusac. She was married to George E. Loy, of Morrow County, in 1840 and coming to Hancock in 1854, settling on the farm known as the Marshall farm two miles east of McComb.

[Marion Co., Ohio Marriage Records Vol 2 Page 136 gives the marriage date for George and Margaret Loy as 27 Dec 1838] On the 29th of March 1856 her husband received injuries from a spike which caused his death. To this union were born two sons and three daughters. On June 29 1859, she was married to Robert Poe who died in June 1870. To this union were born two sons, Robert Poe and James Poe. She resided upon the farm in Liberty township up to a short time ago, when she moved to McComb. Those present at the bedside when the spirit fled were, her brother Isaac Cusac, her sister, Mrs. M.E. Mulford, of Shawtown, her daughter, Mrs. S. E. Barnhill of Marion, Iowa, M.A. Loy, R. M. Poe and Miss Loy of this place. One daughter Mrs. M. E. Fluckey and one son, J.T. Poe, having preceded her in to the better world. The end came quietly and peacefully. She was member of the Presbyterian church, which she joined at the tender age of eleven years, remaining a faithful member and increasing her faith in God up to the time of her death. She leaves besides a host of friends, three brothers, Isaac, James, and William Cusac, of this place, two sisters, Mrs. Mary Mulford, of Shawtown, and Mrs. Sarah Reed of Findlay, two sons, Martin Loy and R. M. Poe, of McComb, two daughters Mrs. Sarah Barnhill, of Marion Iowa, and Miss M. E. Loy, of this place. Twenty grandchildren and eleven great grandchildren, mourn her loss. Funeral services were held at the residence of Martin Loy last sunday. Rev. Montgomery of Findlay, officiating. Interment at Indian Green Cemetery.

Dies at the age of eight-three of the infirmities of old age. Sunday afternoon at his home in Portage township, John Cusac, a well-to-do farmer, passed away from the infirmities of old age. He was 83 years of age. The funeral was held this morning at ten o'clock from the Blanchard Presbyterian church. there was a large crowd in attendance. the deceased was born in Perry county May 23, 1820. In 1838 he moved to this county where the remainder of his life was spent. He was married to Miss Nancy Bell, January 21, 1841. Eight children resulted from the union, four of whom survive. The deceased was a staunch member of the Blanchard Presbyterian church. In 1865 he was elected ruling elder. W. J. Cusac, J.S. Cusac, Mrs. Jacob Mitchell and Mrs. George Mitchell are the surviving children. George Cusac, of this city, is a nephew. AGED WOMAN IS CALLED BY DEATH -

Mrs. Sarah E. Reed Dies at 88 Years

After Long Illness From Heart Trouble.

RESIDENT OF COUNTY NEARLY ENTIRE LIFE-Many Years - Two Brothers Survive

Mrs. Sarah E. Reed, 88, died at her residence, 220 West Lincoln street at 6:30 Sunday morning from heart trouble. She had been in ill-health for about a year and bedfast for about six weeks.

Before her marriage, Mrs. Reed was Miss Sarah E. Cusac and as a member of the of the best known families in Hancock county, she had a wide acquaintance. She was the daughter of Mr. And Mrs. Daniel Cusac, and was born in Perry county, Ohio, Nov. 26, 1826. With her parents, she moved to Hancock county when she was twelve years old and had resided her ever since.

Lived in Findlay Many Years.

Her parents resided on a farm in Liberty township. When she was married to John Reed, she continued to live in Liberty township. Her husband died thirty years ago and shortly afterward she moved to Findlay purchasing the property on East Lincoln street where she had lived since that time. She had no children.

Mrs. Reed was a member of the Presbyterian church all her life. When a resident of Liberty township she attended the Blanchard Presbyterian church and after coming to Findlay she joined the First Presbyterian church.

Those Who Survive

She is survived by two brothers, William Cusac, of Liberty township, and Captain Isaac Cusac, of McComb. Six other brothers and sisters are dead. They are: John Cusac, James Cusac, Mrs. Mary Ann Mulford, Mrs. Nancy Cooper, Mrs. Jenliza Cooper, and Mrs. Margaret Poe.

Almost ever since she moved to Findlay her nephew, M. C. Kelley, has resided with her. He was her companion when he was but a boy and continued to live in her home after his marriage and until her death.

The funeral service will be at the home at 10:30 o'clock Tuesday morning.
