In 1820 he was in Frederick co., MD., with three children. He was in Marion co., OH 1830 with 4 sons 2 daughters. He was between 40 & 50. His wife was between 30-40. In 1840 he was not living but his wife was with the same children as above plus a child one year old, George Stevens. The children divided between her own household and that of her son George who was married but had no children at the time. In 1850 the children were all married but Margaret and the child George Stevens."
 (Note: check census date for Marion Co. Unlikely in Md. and Oh the same year.)
