General Notes: Wife - Mary Ann Dandison

- 1) I remember visiting Grandma Hopson as a small child. I was born December 1926 and as she died in April 1930, I was probably around 4 years old. I sat on a foot stool at her feet and because she was looking directly at me, I didn't believe she couldn't see me. Mother had told me Grandma Hopson was blind.
- 2) 18 November 1944, Extracted Obituary- "THE OWOSSO ARGUS PRESS, Thursday, April 24, 1930, Page 2 Hazelton Pioneer is taken by death. Mrs. Mary Hopson 85, dies last night after a short illness. Mrs. Mary Hopson, 85 years of age, died last night at 7:30 at her home in Easton after a short illness. She has been failing all winter but was not taken seriously ill until Wednesday night. Complications were the cause of death. Funeral services will be held Sunday, afternoon at 2:00pm at the East Church of Christ, Rev. C. H. Lyons officiating. Burial will be made at the West Haven Cemetery. Mrs. Hopson was born January 28, 1845 in Pontiac Twp, the daughter of Mr. & Mrs. Robert Dandison. She moved to Easton Twp. as a young lady and had lived there since. In 1865 she married Edgar W. Pearsall. Mr. Pearsall died in 1892, and she married Norman L. Hopson in 1893. She was a member of the Easton Church of Christ. She is survived by her husband; one son, Pearl R. Pearsall of New Haven Twp., two daughters Mrs. H. P. Underwood of New Haven Township and Mrs. M. L. Bittell of Rush Township; 13 grandchildren and 11 great-grandchildren.

- 2) 25 February 1970, my father (Roy Bittell) told me the Crickmores owned a general store on the North side of the road in Easton, Michigan. Grandma Hopson lived west of the store and is buried in the Easton Cemetery.
