General Notes: Husband - Henry Pearsall³

1) Henry Pearsall, son of Thomas Pearsall of England and Virginia, resided at Pearsall, Hellgate Neck, and Hempstead, Long Island, New Netherland.

2) Page 1054 - November 10, 1654, Henry Pearsall was nominated to the Governor to be appointed a magistrate. Henry Pearsall was a townsman in 1658 together with Robert Jackson, John Smith, Robert Carl, and Thomas Rushmore. He appears to have acted as treasurer of the town in 1658.

3) Page 1055 - Henry Pearsall was chosen at a town meeting for nomination to the Governor for Magistrate, November 17 1658 and again nominated, February 4, 1662.

4) Page 1055 - Christ's First Presbyterian Church in Hempstead, Long Island....To the descendants of Henry Pearsall it is a visible evidence of his personality and spirituality, and constantly reminds us that this active man of affairs was at all times the supporter of the church and made many person sacrifices for its welfare and prosperity.

General Notes: Wife - Ann Valentine¹⁵

1) Ann Valentine, widow of Moyles Williams. The Valentines were Dutch-English traders. They were associated with the Pearsalls in Virginia in Isle of Wight County, where they were also closely related by marriage with the Marshall family, so much so that it is generally accepted that from the marriage of a Valentine and a Marshall descended John Marshall, Chief Justice of the United States, and Thomas Marshall, Vice-president of the United States.

General Notes: Child - George Pearsall [2759]¹⁶

1) George remained connected with Christ's First Presbyterian Church, but did not seem to have had any part in its management.

2) George Pearsall resided at Herrick, Hempstead, L. I., N. Y., near what is now (1928) Searington.

General Notes: Child - Nathaniel Pearsall [2770]¹⁷

Nathaniel was a member of the religious Society of Friends.

Nathaniel Pearsall resided in Hempstead, Long Island, New Netherland, later call ye Province of New York. He married Martha Seaman, daughter of Captain John Seaman, and his wife Martha Moore. Martha Pearsall died 7 mo., 6 1712.

General Notes: Child - Daniel Pearsall [2771]¹⁸

1) Will proved May 20, 1703, resided at Hempstead, Long Island, N.Y.

2) Daniel remained connected with Christ's First Presbyterian Church, but did not seem to have had any part in its management.
