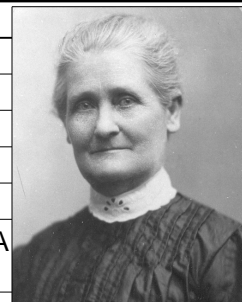

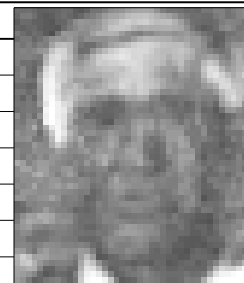

Pioneer of County Dead at 92 years. Mrs. Katherine Anne Feters passes away Wednesday. Came here at the age of seven from East, in Prairie Schooner. Lived in log cabin in wildernes. Katherine Anne Feters, 92 years old, died from complication of diseases and infirmities of age at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Louis Marshall on West Sandusky street at 11 o'clock Wednesday morning after having been bed-ridden for the last 11 months.

She was the daughter of Charles and Betsy Phillips, and was born Oct 9, 1826 in what was known as Waynesburg, Pa., now known as McVay. When she was seven years old, the family came to Ohio in a covered prairie schooner and settled on Tawa Creek, near Benton Ridge. The journey, which was long and difficult, took four weeks. A family by the name of Thompson came with the Phillips family, Mrs. Epley, living south of Findlay, being the only surviving member of this party.

The early pioneer life was a fascinating one and was full of interesting happenings. The first home, a rude hut, was snowed under for three days, and a later structure was scarcely adequate to afford protection from the wolves which howled around the door each night. All sorts of wild game was abundant, and the family larder was largely dependent upon the accuracy of Mrs. Fetter's husband's shooting.

An early episode in the life of the deceased occurred when she was 13 years old, at which time she and another girl rode on horseback to Findlay with some chickens to sell. The other girl disposed of her's for six cents each, while Mrs. Feters sold hers for eight cents to the late Judge Cory.

At the age of 18 she was married to Peter Feters and to this union 13 children were born, six of whom are dead.

Those who are dead are: Andrew, a soldier in the Civil War, Mary Ellen Smith, Eli, Criselda, Elizabeth and Lemuel. The living are: Mrs. Sarah Bond, Deweyville; Mrs. Louis Marshall, Mrs. T. J. Baker and Irvin, in Findlay; Mrs. Clayton Vansant, Mich.; Uriah, Arlington, and Isaiah, Benton Ridge.

Mrs. Feters was a member of the Powell Evangelical church, which she joined shortly after her marriage. During her later years she spent a great deal of time in making quilts, having made 55 during the last five years.

Funeral services will be held at 2 o'clock Friday afternoon at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Marshall, on West Sandusky street with interment in the Powell cemetery."

At the Tallahassee State Library, I found this book, "A New & Complete Gazetteer of the U.S." by Baldwin. (Gen 910.3 B182) On page 1258, I found "Waynesburg, a small village of Mifflin Co., Pa." I believe Catherine was born in a small village in Mifflin Co., named Waynesburg and today it is called McVeytown.

"Shortly after the marriage, they were converted and received into membership at the Powell Evangelical Church which still stands on Powell Road at Hancock, Ohio." (From Tomas Feters)

Andrew Feters enlisted on the union side as a Private on 2 May 1864 at the age of 19. He enlisted on 6 May 1864 in the 134 Ohio Infantry (National Guard) as a Private in Company B. (Film Number M552 roll 33) He mustered out on 31 Aug 1864 at Camp Chase, Ohio.

Regimental History of the One Hundred and Thirty-fourth Infantry, - Col., James B Armstrong; Lieut.-Col., David W. Todd; Maj., John C. Baker. This regiment was organized at Camp Chase, May 6, 1864, to serve for 100 days. It was composed of two companies of 94th battalion Ohio National Guard, from Shelby county, one company of the 58th battalion, from Hancock county, and the 4th regiment Ohio National Guard, from Shelby county. On May 7 it was ordered to Cumberland, MD., via Parkersburg, W. VA. It remained at Cumberland until June 6, when it moved to Washington City and proceeded from there to White House, It did not disembark, but proceeded immediately to City Point, where it aided in pontooning the river, building roads, and on June 17 was engaged in a skirmish with the enemy near Port Walthall Junction. It mustered out on Aug. 31, 1864. 1 enlisted killed or mortally wounded; 30 enlisted died of disease or accident. Battles fought 17 June 1864 at Port Walthall, VA; 28 July 1864 at Bermuda Hundred, VA. Source: The Union Army, Vol. 2

Marie Bates reports Elizabeth Feters married Phillip Powell and that Elizabeth died 2 Oct 1869. If her birth date of 11 Feb 1846 and 2 Oct 1869 is correct, she was 23 when she died.

The History of Hancock County by Beardsly - "Elizabeth Feters, daughter of Peter and Catherine Feters married Phillip Powell son of Peter and Mary (Alspaugh) Powell." This is incorrect. Elizabeth Feters, daughter of Peter and Catherine Feters was born 11 Feb 1846 and died 2 Sept 1862 at the age of 16 years. If the above death date reported by Marie Bates is correct, she could have been the wife of Phillip Powell, son of Peter & Mary.
