From Mark Irland of Chesaning, Michigan Papers found at the Chesaning Public Library: James Vincent Judd resided at Avon, NY until the fall of 1845 when he moved his family to Grand Blanc, Genesee County, Michigan and in November 1854 moved to Maple Grove, Saginaw County, Michigan, Section 35. They moved in 1882 to the NW corner of section 14, Chesaning Township on the Volkmer road. He was a farmer. Military Service; 36:79 record of service Michigan Vol, 1861-5: "Enlisted in Co. G, 6th Mich. Cavalry, August 30 1862 at Maple Grove for 3 years, age 40. Mustered Oct 11, 1862. Discharged at Washington, DC, Oct 1, 1863 on account of disease contracted by exposure. He then served as an Army teamster in Washington.  
He attended the common schools of N.Y. State. Church of God in Maple Grove, Congregation Church and later member of M.E. Church; National League of Veterans & Sons.
