Deceased was well advanced in years, being in his eightieth year. The old gentleman purchased the laudanum for Mrs. Ganson, who is affected with asthma and uses it to relieve her sufferings and placed it beside or near the bottle that contained his own medicine, and in some unaccountable manner mistook the bottle of poison for his own. By heavy lifting in carrying wounded soldiers off the field he contacted rupture of his let side, which still continues and greatly incapacitates him for performance of manual labor. Received hospital treatment as follows: Carver Hospt, Washington in June 1865. Since leaving this service he resided mostly at or near Flint, Michigan. His occupation has been farmer. When enrolled he was a farmer and for the purpose of prosecuting his claim he hereby appoints P.H. Fitzgerald, of Indianapolis, Indiana, his attorney in fact, with full power of substitution and with authority to receive his Pension Certificate. His post office address is Flint, County of Genesee, State of Michigan. Witnessed by Charles C. Beehan and George B. Daly. Signature of Claimant, Nathan Ganson.

Adjutant Generals Office, Washington, D. C. May 25 1876 I have the honor to acknowledge the receipt from your office of application for Pension No. 216938 and to return it herewith,.....It appears from the rolls on file in this Office that Nathan Ganson was enrolled on the 14th day of January 1864 at Mundy in Co. G, 8th Regiment of Michigan Volunteers, to serve 3 years or during the war, and mustered into service as a Recruit on the 18th day of January 1864 at Corunna, in Co. G, 8th Regiment of Michigan Vol. to serve 3 year or during the war On the Muster Roll of Co G, of that Regiment, from enrolment to April 30, 1865, he is reported as present with the Co. "Detailed in Ambulance Corps" May & June 1865. Absent Detailed in Ambulance Corps M.O.Roll of Co. dated July 30/65 reports him absent, sick in hospital, Washington C.C. He was mustered out on Detachment Roll July 10/65 at Carver G. H. Washington D.C. Co. was stationed near Petersburg, VA in Spring of 1865. Signed, ? W. Benjamin, Assistant Adjutant General.

I found Alfred Ganson in the 1860 Census, Genesee County, Michigan, 1st Ward City of Flint. I wonder if he is a brother to Nathan because A.S. Ganson was a witness on her application for Nathan's pension. Although, Albert S Ganson, son, may be the witness.

- a.) THE GENESEE DEMOCRAT, Vol. XXXVIII. No. 6 Flint, Michigan, Saturday, August 1, 1885.
- b.) The funeral of the late Mrs. Nathan Ganson was held on Thursday morning at 10:30 o'clock from the residence of Mr. Eugene George [Julia's daughter, Harriett] on the Fentonville road.
- c.) The funeral of the late Mrs. Ganson was held Thursday from her late residence in the town of Mundy. A large number of Flint people were present at the services.
- d.) Mrs. Nathan Ganson who was killed by the cars Tuesday, recently said to her daughter-in-law, Mrs. A. Ganson, that she wished to die at her (Mrs. A. Ganson's) house, and that she hoped her old horse would live as long as she did. Her wishes were both singularly fulfilled.
- e.) The coroner's jury in the case of the death of Miss Julia A. Ganson, met Thursday and returned a verdict that death was the result of being struck by the locomotive at the Fenton crossing as before stated and added that "the death of the said Julia A. Ganson was not caused by the wrongful act or default of any person, and the engineer in charge of said train did not violate any statute of this state or ordinance of the city of Flint in running the..... In the Application for Accrued Pension (Widows) State of Michigan, County of Genesee on the 6 March 1884, Julia A Ganson declares she is the lawful widow of Nathan Ganson, that he died on the 14th day of February, 1884 and was granted a pension by Certificate No. 216846. That he had been paid a pension by the Pension Agent at Detroit up to the 4 day of December 1883. She was married to the said Nathan Ganson on the 26th day of July 1826 at Livingston County in the State of New York, that her name before said marriage was Julia A. Swift; that her residence is First Street, City of Flint, County Genesee, Sate of Michigan and her Post-office address is Flint, Genesee Co., Michigan. Also personally appeared F. A. Cirn (?) and A.S. Ganson both residing at Flint City, Michigan who, being duly sworn, say that they were present and saw Julia A Ganson sign her name and that they know her to be the lawful widow of Nathan Ganson who died on the 14th day of February, 1884; "That they were at the home where he died and saw him dead & attended the funeral, also know they lived together as man & wife. signed F. A. Corin (?) A.S. Ganson 6th day of March 1884."
